Miss Daisy Sandidge, 1510 Church street, Evanston, is the first woman in the history of the suburb to seek election to the city council. She is a candidate for the short term from the 5th ward, created by the council's action in ousting Edward B. Jourdain Jr., Negro alderman. Miss Sandidge was formerly chairman of her ward organization of the league of women voters, and revised the 1931 edition of the Illinois Voters Handbook published by the league.
